Paige Joy is a Washington D.C. based Filmmaker, Social Media Content Creator, & lifelong Nightmare fan. Her love for film was sparked when she first saw Wes Craven's 1996 masterpiece Scream at 12 years old. In 2016 she Directed the popular fan film "Don't Fall Asleep: The Untold Nancy Thompson Story" which

was the first fan film to ever feature an original cast members involvement.

Since then, Paige has written and directed several short films including **AdHerent**, **Crushed**, & **The Friend**. She was the 2nd unit DP on "Angela: The Sleep Away Camp Doc" and in 2017 launched production of FredHeads, The Documentary.

With FredHeads, Paige has traveled the country for the past 5 years filming countless stories of fans from the A Nightmare on Elm Street fandom on how this franchise has not only impacted their lives, but in some cases has saved them.

Kim Gunzinger is the co-founder of Venn Pictures, a Producer, Director, Actress, Script Consultant, and Talent Coordinator. She has always had a passion for the arts going back to childhood. Kim attended her first horror convention in 2005, and she realized there was a place for passionate

horror fans to come together. She would meet some of her closest friends, found inspiration to pursue her passion for horror and film, and actively sought out numerous indie productions. She was the Executive Producer on **Easter Sunday**, the Nightmare fan film **Don't Fall Asleep**, **Adherent**, **Crushed** as well as the second unit DP for the **Angela**: **The Official Sleepaway Camp Documentary**.

Kim attributes her involvement in the horror community to Robert Englund, Freddy Krueger and the entire Nightmare franchise.

Diandra Lazor is a producer, content creator, cosplayer, and YouTuber. She became a horror fan in her early high school years after a dream sparked her interest in A Nightmare on Elm Street and Freddy Krueger. Instantly, she connected with the character of Nancy Thompson.

Diandra quickly jumped online to connect with other FredHeads on message boards. Soon after, she began to cosplay as Nancy Thompson and championed the heroine across the internet. In 2016, she played Nancy in "Don't Fall Asleep," an A Nightmare on Elm Street fan film dedicated to Nancy's story between the original Nightmare film and Dream Warriors. The film features Heather Langenkamp back as Nancy from beyond the grave and is available to watch on YouTube.

Since then, Diandra has been featured in **Fangoria**; written for **Shudder's The Bite**; hosted a podcast solely dedicated to A Nightmare on Elm Street, **Elm Street Radio**; and partnered with brands including **Bloody Disgusting**, **Big Honcho Media**, and **Universal Pictures**. But above all else, FredHeads The Documentary is her largest and most important endeavor. A Nightmare on Elm Street has changed her life. Diandra's career, friends, and current way of life was all made possible by the franchise. She doesn't know where she would be without it. That's why the FredHeads Documentary is so important.
